The Bark Park is a year-round setting located on 65 acres, dedicated to dogs and their human companions. The facility offers pet owners a beautiful and safe environment to exercise and socialize their dogs and promotes responsible pet ownership.

Dock Diving

Come and participate on the only regulation outdoor dock diving platform in Western Pennsylvania. The dock is 40 feet long, 8 feet wide, and covered with astro-turf. Boarding Kennels

The new facility can accommodate up to ten dogs. The kennel area has radiant heated floors through-out and is air conditioned. We will provide each dog with an elevated bed and bedding, up to three mealtimes daily, 7 potty outs, and indoor/outdoor playtime or daily walks. Regular head pats, chin scratches and belly rubs along with a nightly "Bedtime" biscuit will add to the special care your dog will receive from the trained staff.






Immunization Requirements:

The Dog House requires proof of a negative fecal test and specific immunizations for all **boarders**. A complete list can be found on the website, or by calling the Dog House.

Immunizations should be administered at least 2 weeks prior to boarding. Please bring a signed copy of your current vaccination record or complete the Bark Park Health Record Form found at the Bark Park website. Please also check the site for the Boarding Agreement as well as some breed restrictions.

Doggie Day Care



Instead of crating, confining, or leaving your pet alone all day, consider leaving your dog at Doggie Day Care at The Dog House. The Dog House will provide each owner's dog with a safe, fun, stimulating environment under the careful supervision of our trained staff while the owner shops, runs errands, or stays longer hours at work. Dogs will use a great deal of energy during daycare which makes for a well-rested pet in the evening and owners will pick up a tired dog whose low energy level matches that of the owner.

The laundra-mutt includes:
